

Missions

Mission Madness: In April, eight youth joined Pastor Melissa and Tim Thornhill for a weekend mission trip to Bristol, sponsored by Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of Virginia. Here is what one of our youth, Jacob Sloan, had to say about the trip:

Mission Madness was a fun experience because I have never done mission work in the middle of the year, usually only in the summer. Not only that, but I was able to spend valuable time with the younger youth and get to know them better. Apart from my experience with the mission work that I did, our hosts treated us very nicely and made us excellent food to eat, and the worship service on our last day was also amazing. I thoroughly enjoyed helping the Red Cross go door to door, offering the installation of free smoke detectors. There were two other groups that our youth were split up into for work; one went to a park to do some much needed clean-up, and the second group went to a local thrift store to do some sorting of inventory. I would do Mission Madness again if given the opportunity.

Intergenerational Missions Week 2022, July 17-22: This year, part of our missions week will be spent serving our neighbors here in Roanoke, and the last part of the week will be spent in Danville. We will be working with Friendship House here in Roanoke, helping a mission team from Alabama prepare a house to begin a home for Afghani refugees. We will also be providing meals for that mission team. If you are interested in being part of the mission week but aren't able to do manual labor, we will have other opportunities for you; just notify Tim Thornhill, Pastor Melissa, or the church office that you are interested. On Thursday and Friday, we will be in Danville, learning from Grace and Main Ministries about intentional communities and joining their work around their city.

Missions Fundraiser: On August 6, our church is hosting HAMfest, a gathering of amateur radio enthusiasts. We have the opportunity to raise money for the Pat Conner Missions Fund by selling breakfast and lunch to the 200 or so people who are expected to participate. We'll end the evening with a sweet time of dessert, worship, and a devotion. Each event will begin at 5:30 and end by 8:00. Our first gathering will be Fri., June 24, and we will also meet on July 29 & August 19.

Celtic Christianity Bible Study and Worship: Colonial Presbyterian Church has invited us to join them this summer in learning more about Celtic Christianity. During a time when Christianity was not flourishing elsewhere, Christianity continued to spread in Scotland, Ireland, and Wales. The unique nature of the faith and practice of those Christians, particularly their emphasis on hospitality, creation, prayer, and whole-life spirituality, can teach us much about what it means to be a faithful follower of Jesus today. Once a month, we will gather to study John Philip Newell's teachings about Celtic Christianity, and later that month, we will worship in the Celtic style.
